As wanderers happen upon this silly little art they are greeted with a 'Rules of Engagement' sign inviting them to take in the feast for the eyes contained within the tent. The seats are recessed into either side of a large piece of furniture and are supported in a way that allows them to each spin on their center axis while being connected to one another so that the action of one is deferred to the other.

## Memento Mutabis: A Spirit Collection

Memento Mutabis is assemblage sculpture that reimagines the classic memento mori motif featuring handmade glowing mushrooms, bones and other natural objects ethically collected on the unceded lands of the W̱SÁNEĆ, Songhees and Esquimalt Nations. The arranged objects are contained under a vintage glass bell jar, formally referencing a natural history museum's collection, which invites the viewer to question the colonial impulse to tag and categorize nature. While memento mori translates to "remember you shall die", Memento Mutabis asks the viewer to "remember you shall transform". Unlike a scientific display, Memento Mutabis seeks to honor the spirit of the humming bird who raised their kin in that nest, the snake who met their end on that dusty dirt road and the deer whose bones waited patiently on that mountainside. This sculpture is not a memento mori because it is not entirely dead; the glowing mushrooms gently overgrowing the natural objects remind us that all living things depend on the death of others in order to exist. Death is not an ending, rather a transmutation of energy.

## Miffy's Mimosas

Miffy's Mimosas: slinging cool refreshments by day & providing roaming art, light and sparkles between dance-floors by night. Miffy's Mimosa is a day and night art cart used for slinging refreshments by day & providing art/light/objects for the crusty burners at night while roaming wild and free between dancefloors. #MobileArt #RovingArt

The Pud is the cozy place for us to connect in a close and quiet setting. Its a great place for lazy daytime shady hangs, nighttime dance breaks, and late night melting into a puddle.

## Reflections of the Divine - Talk to God

"Reflections of the Divine – Talk to God" is designed to facilitate a profound journey of self-discovery and introspection. This interactive installation uses an infinity mirror effect and a telephone handset to create a space where participants can engage in a unique and personal dialogue with themselves, symbolically representing a conversation with a divine presence – the God within us all. The mirrored chamber, with its serene and contemplative ambiance, encourages participants to reflect deeply on their own existence and identity. The vintage telephone handset acts as a conduit, allowing individuals to voice their thoughts and emotions, creating a connection that feels as though they are speaking to a higher power. The artist's intention is to highlight the interconnectedness of self and spirituality, illustrating that the divine resides within each of us. The infinite reflections created by the mirrors symbolize the endless layers of self-awareness and the continuous search for meaning. The soft ethereal lighting enhances this contemplative space, making the experience otherworldly and introspective. Through this interaction, participants are prompted to recognize and converse with the divine aspect within themselves, ultimately fostering a deeper understanding and acceptance of their inner thoughts and emotions. This art project is located within The Church of Unreasonable Happiness theme camp.

## Return to Eden

When you're ready, enter through the illuminated floral portal. Only then will you discover what awaits for you on the other side.

## Roy G Biv

Looking for a H2H? A rippling rainbow if lucky? Look for the soft spiky creature to get physically heart to heart & join us for rainbow filled events. We all need a good heart to heart, be that a conversation or a really good hug. This sculpture provides that opportunity under a soft glow of rippling rainbow colours. From a distance it might appear like a soft spiky creature resting or a sunflower raising out of the ground. Intentionally left open for the participant to create their own narrative. As you move closer to the piece, an opening at both ends is apparent. As you move into the space you are bathed in a soft rainbow of colours which changes depending on the time of day and intensity of the sun, and 12 colourful wood platforms of varying heights are strategically placed. The colourful platforms are an opportunity to find equality, to sit or to stand, depending on your desire for a face to face conversation or a heart to heart hug, with one person or a handful. The main portion of this sculpture is made of 2 layers of fabric that will be inflated with 2 fans. The upper layer of fabric is made of 3 different colours that as the sun moves across the sculpture will create a rainbow of sorts with colour mixing on the lower white surface. At night, a projector will project a stunning visual treat onto the underbelly.

## Royal Flush

White lights inside the portapotties for business purposes, and a red/green occupancy light. Powered 100% by used disposable vapes! This portapotty lighting project is powered 100% by scavenged disposable vape batteries, which have been diverted from the landfill. A battery-powered lighting unit would be installed in each portapotty stall (up to a total of 50 stalls); attaching to the inside of the portapotty using zap-straps. Installing / removing the units at the end of the event will leave no trace in the portapotty. Shining through the white plastic roof of the portapotty (from the inside -> outside) is a red/green light, which indicates whether the toilet is occupied (red for occupied, green for unoccupied). This helps people waiting in line immediately know which stalls are available for use. The inside of the toilet is lit by a white light and a diffusion stencil — casting a subtle, intricate pattern on the inside and providing ample light to see inside. A collection bin for empty disposable vapes is also present, which reminds people of the up-cycling nature of the project — and saves even more disposable vapes from the landfill and help us power more portapotties in future years. #ArtSomewhere

## Spacenet

Spacenet! It is a net woven using paracord, round slings and 11mm rope. It will be there for relaxing, bouncing, connecting, and overall fun having! The concept is to have a basic net woven prior to BitF. It will be rigged between trees in the same area where the slack camp will rig slacklines, it will be rigged at an accessible height. During the day it can be utilized by anyone as a hangout spot, laying or sitting in the net. After dark several UV lights will be turned on and bright, UV reactive paracord will be available for anyone to add to the weaving of the net, creating patterns, words or pictures that will become part of the net. Many of the slack camp members already know how to weave spacenets and will be available to teach and guide anyone who wishes to add to the spacenet.

## Table it for Later

"Table it for Later" is an immersive, interactive art project happening at the Quitters Bar. Come create a living memory artifact by capturing the eve. The "Table it for Later" project is an artistic initiative specifically curated for a themed camp bar space. At the heart of this project, we have two uniquely-crafted table tops, each one featuring an inset space designed to become a vessel for preserving collective memories.

### The Koala's Nest

The Koalas Nest– An immersive habitat bubble for your olfactory senses! The Immersive Habitat: Fresh and Tranquil are the words that will come to the minds of visitor. The Koalas Nest will be a beautiful sensory retreat for 1–2 people to enter, relax and take in the refreshing and therapeutic smell of eucalyptus. Ambient forest sounds (it is burn in the forest after all!) will be playing on a Bluetooth speaker as the water/essential oil vaporizer fills the sensory bubble (!) for you to enjoy. The Interior décor will resemble the forest canopy, you will feel you are suspended amongst eucalyptus trees and will feel the softness of air moving gently. Soft bedding invites you to lay down or sit and cozy textured pillows/touchables conjure up happiness and connection with nature. In the nighttime, a sky of twinkling stars sparkle above your head, reflected on the ceiling of the tent.

A table made of video screens that you can play, with video feedback. Two giant Pawns control & capture the show which is you, playing with light toy

Enjoy a spectacular lighting show, as your mind will be captivated by over 500 different patterns throughout the 3 days this tower will make its debut at BitF. Tower of Luminescence featured at Camp Dark Desires has been our camp community build project for the last 2 months. This 18-foot tower has been fitted with 2000 individually addressable LED lights to display AI-generated lighting patterns, with an audio interface from our DJ booth.

### Transidermy in the Forest

Look for each animal spirit under a multicoloured umbrella. If you're still enough, they may even come back to life;) Transidermy in the Forest is the Burner adaptation of my visual art that I call Transidermy. Part party-animal, part animal totem, each piece has a name and unique personality that will encourage the viewer to invite certain attributes into their lived experience. Each piece will be hung from a board that will be ratchet-strapped to a tree (so the tree remains unharmed). A multicoloured umbrella will be attached via a welded umbrella holder to protect the pieces from the elements. The required power will be solely used to recharge the batteries. #ArtSomewhere
